It stood there, a masterpiece of design, with sculpted lines that effortlessly blend power and elegance. Our model of choice comes in a beautiful baby blue: a true epitome of understated luxury – an approach that Ferrari looks to dwelve deeper into with the launch of this new model.

Its innovation comes in the form of a retractable soft top, an engineering marvel, that flawlessly transforms the new, soft top coupe into a breathtaking open-top, revealing its true soul to the world. It not only adds to the car's aesthetics but also enhances its aerodynamics, maintaining the sleek lines even when the top is down. Featuring special bespoke fabric in numerous tailored options, the soft top, boasting acoustic comfort on a par with retractable hard tops, can be opened in just 13.5 seconds at speeds up to 60 km/h. For all those, who are disturbed by the wind factor that inevitably comes into play when driving a convertible, be assured that top-down driving comfort is ensured by a patented wind deflector that is integrated into the rear seat backrest. We can testify, first-hand, that the wind deflector does its job more than perfectly: a true feat!

The cabin is an embodiment of Italian luxury, with sumptuous leather and carbon fibre accents that exude sophistication. Our favourite element within the cabin is undoubtedly Ferrari's signature steering wheel, reminiscent of a video game joy stick ensuring that every control is at your fingertips, designed for ultimate control and comfort during high-speed drives along Sardinia's winding roads. The Roma Spider's exceptional and precise steering responds to every whim, making it an absolute joy to drive. Moreover, the wheel is deliciously garnished with the cherry on top: the famous "Manettino" dial. The Manettino, meaning "little switch" in Italian, allows the driver to seamlessly adjust the vehicle's electronic systems to optimise for road conditions or driver preference. First designed by Frank Stephenson, the Manettino takes the driver from comfort mode all the way to ESC-OFF Mode – a setting designated for expert drivers only. This driving mode disables the car's Electronic Stability Control system entirely!

MOBILITY

burning rays of the Italian, midday summer sun, as we cruised along the Sardinian coast, we couldn't help but marvel at the ingenuity of the soft top's engineering. The noise insulation was impressive, even at high speeds, and ensured that the sound of the engine remained the primary melody on our journey.
